Composition : Lomefloxacin 3mg/ml. **Indications :** Bacterial infections including conjunctivitis, blepharitis, blepharoconjunctivitis, lomefloxacin susceptible organisms and staphylococcus aureusinduced corneal ulcers.

Dosage and administration : Adults and children (above 1 year of age) : Insert 1 drop into the lower conjunctival sac 2-3 times daily. At the beginning of the treatment, applications should be more frequent, apply 1 drop every hour during 6-10 hour. Duration of the treatment: 7 to 9 days. Or as directed by the physician

Side effects : Slight and transient burning immediately after instillation of the eye drops has been reported. Although photo toxicity has not been reported after ophthalmic use, photosensitization is possible.

Contraindication : Hypersensitivity to the active ingredient, to excipients or to quinolones.

Precautions : Long term treatment with antibiotics may enhance development of secondary fungal infections or may support growth of non susceptible bacteria. During treatment with lomefloxacin intensive exposure to sunlight or UV-radiation should be avoided.

Opthaflox Sterile Eye Drops

Use in pregnancy and lactation : Pregnancy Category C by FDA. Packing : 5ml in plastic dropper bottle.
