Black Cohosh 40mg Capsule

Scientific Name: Cimicifuga racemosa

Composition:

Each capsule contains Black Cohosh (Cimicifuga racemosa) 40mg dried powder.

Description:

Black cohosh (*Cimicifuga racemosa*) is popular as an alternative to hormonal therapy in the treatment of menopausal (climacteric) symptoms such as hot flashes, mood disturbances, diaphoresis, palpitations and vaginal dryness.

Indication:

Black Cohosh is indicated for the treatment of premenstrual syndromes (PMS) and menopausal syndrome. The herb has also been used traditionally for rheumatism and inflammatory conditions.

Dosages & administration:

1-2 capsules daily or, as directed by the registered physician.

Side effects:

Generally Black Cohosh is well tolerated. The adverse events associated with the use of Black Cohosh includes gastroenteritis, nausea and vomiting.

Contraindications:

No significant contraindication is observed.

Precautions:

Black cohosh should not be substituted for hormone replacement therapy with estrogen. There is no evidence that the herb contains protective effects against osteoporosis.

Use in pregnancy and lactation:

The use of Black Cohosh is contraindicated during pregnancy due to an increased risk of spontaneous abortion. Breast-feeding is not recommended while using this drug.

Drug interactions:

Concurrent use of Azathioprine & Cyclosporine with Black Cohosh may result in reduced immunosuppressive effectiveness.

Storage:

Keep out of reach of the children. Keep away from direct sunlight. Store below 30° C in a dry place.

Packing:

Each box contains 8x4's = 32 Capsules in alu-alu blister pack.
